Stefano Rastelli is research fellow at the University of Greenwich (UK) where he directs the NOLTA (Neurocognition Of Language Teaching/Acquisition) Lab. Stefano obtained a PhD in linguistics at the University of Pavia (Italy) in 2006 and has taught second language acquisition at the Universities of Milano, Pavia, Verona, Salerno, and Padua.

From 2003 to 2008 he served as Italian Language coordinator for I.E.S. study abroad at the University of Milan. From 2010 to 2013 he has served as assistent professor at the University of Pavia.

Since 2010 he serves as the head of the Marco Polo Turandot Programme and is responsible for 25 academic members and staff and of hundreds of Chinese learners of Italian in this institution.

He regularly publishes for international journals (*Second Language Research*, *International Review of Applied Linguistics*) and for international publishers (John Benjamins, Multilingual Matters, De Gruyter).

He is co-authored the "Manifesto per l'insegnamento della lingua italiana agli studenti internazionali" which has been recently adopted as a teaching standard by Uni-Italia (Ministry of Foreign Affairs) and by 37 Italian Universities.
