#### Venue

The Spring school will be hosted at <u>Palazzo Vistarino</u>, a historical building of the University of Pavia located in the city center.

#### **Accommodation**

Students will be accommodated in double or single rooms (all rooms are ensuite) in three different places, all located in the city center:

- 1. Palazzo Vistarino: 20 single rooms (50 € per night, breakfast included)
- 2. Collegio Ghislieri: 6 single rooms (60 € per night, breakfast included)
- 3. Collegio Cardano: 4 single rooms (36 € per night, breakfast NOT included)
